- Examples in English: I, you, she, her





# What are subject pronouns?

A personal pronoun that functions as a subject of a sentence.

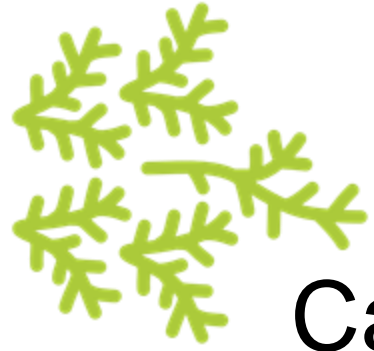
- Example in English: She studies Spanish.

<b>1st person</b>	Yo (I)	Nosotros (We) Nosotras Nosotres
<b>2nd person</b>	Tú (You, informal)	Vosotros (You, informal in Spain) Vosotras Vosotres
<b>3rd person</b>	Él (He) Ella (She) Elle (They, gender neutral) Usted / Ud. (You, formal)	Ellos (They) Ellas Elles (They, gender neutral) Ustedes / Uds. (You)
