# You're going places!

IR + A + PLACE can be used to talk about places you're going.

The verb IR means *to go*.

Conjugations for IR:	Singular	Plural
1st person	(yo) <b>voy</b>	(nosotros/as/es) <b>vamos</b>
2nd person	(tú) <b>vas</b>	(vosotros/as/es) <b>vais</b>
3rd person	(él, ella, elle, Ud.) <b>va</b>	(ellos/as/es, Uds.) <b>van</b>



# How do you use it?

## IR + A + PLACE

- Yo **voy a** la biblioteca. *I am going to the library.*
- Ella **va a** su casa. *She is going to her house.*

## A + EL = AL

When A is followed by the masculine definite article EL, combine A + EL to make AL.

- Nosotros **vamos al** supermercado. *We are going to the supermarket.*
- Ellos **van al** restaurante. *They are going to the restaurant.*
