



## The expression HAY



- HAY is used to express there is or there are. It is an irregular, impersonal form of the verb haber.
  - We use hay to show that something exists.
  - If we want to show that something does not exist, we simply put a
    no in front of it: No hay
  - It does **not** change for number or gender.







## Some examples of HAY



**Hay** un restaurante nuevo en el barrio. *There is* a new restaurant in the neighborhood.

Hay muchos supermercados en mi pueblo. There are a lot of supermarkets in my town.

No hay un gimnasio cerca de mi universidad. There is not a gymnear my university.
