The expression HAY

- HAY is used to express *there is* or *there are*. It is an irregular, impersonal form of the verb *haber*.
 - We use **hay** to show that something exists.
 - If we want to show that something does **not** exist, we simply put a *no* in front of it: **No hay**
 - It does **not** change for number or gender.

Some examples of HAY

Hay un restaurante nuevo en el barrio. *There is a new restaurant in the neighborhood.*

Hay muchos supermercados en mi pueblo. *There are a lot of supermarkets in my town.*

No hay un gimnasio cerca de mi universidad. *There is not a gym near my university.*
