Remember that verbs in Spanish fall into three main groups:

-AR ending

-ER ending

-IR ending



Conjugations of regular -IR verbs



How to conjugate: -IR verbs

Let's look at the steps for how to conjugate the verb
VIVIR (*to live*) in the present tense.

Paso 1. Start with the infinitive verb: **VIVIR**

Paso 2. Take off the **-IR** ending: **VIV-**

Paso 3. Add the corresponding ending from the chart on
the next slide based on the subject/person



Regular -IR verb endings

	Singular	Plural
1st person	(yo) o	(nosotros/as/es) imos
2nd person	(tú) es	(vosotros/as/es) ís
3rd person	(él, ella, elle, Ud.) e	(ellos/as/es, Uds.) en



Conjugations of **VIVIR**

	Singular	Plural
1st person	vivo	vivimos
2nd person	vives	vivis
3rd person	vive	viven

Some examples



Elizondo, España

(Tú) **vives** en un pueblo muy bonito.

You (*informal*) live in a very pretty town.



With the verb **ESCRIBIR**:

Mi abuela **escribe** cartas cada semana.

My grandmother writes letters each week.

With the verb **ASISTIR**:

Mis primos _____ a la universidad de Iowa.

My cousins attend the University of Iowa.
