WHAT ARE **-GO** IN **YO** VERBS?



-go in **yo** verbs are present-tense verbs that have a spelling change in the first-person, singular form (the **yo** form) of the verb.

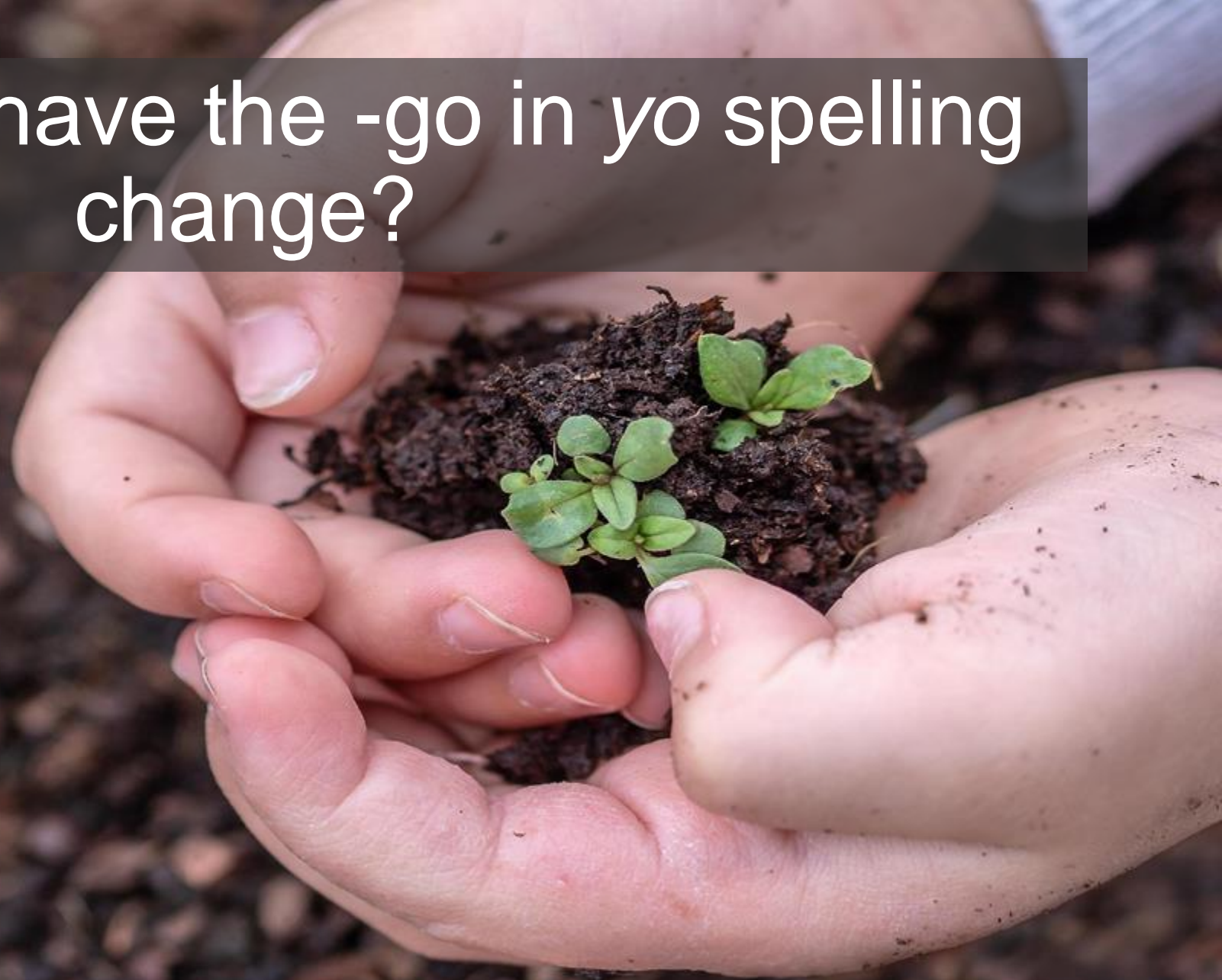
It's possible that some of these verbs also have other spelling changes (like E-IE), but they all share the same ending in the **yo** form.



A review of the verb TENER

	Singular	Plural
1st person	(yo) tengo	(nosotros/as/es) tenemos
2nd person	(tú) tienes	(vosotros/as/es) tenéis
3rd person	(él, ella, elle, Ud.) tiene	(ellos/as/es, Uds.) tienen

Which verbs have the -go in yo spelling change?





-go in *yo* verbs and their conjugations



decir (*to say*): digo

hacer (*to make/do*): hago

tener (*to have*): tengo

traer (*to bring*): traigo

poner (*to put*): pongo

salir (*to leave/go out*): salgo

venir (*to come*): vengo

caer (*to fall*): caigo

oír (*to hear*): oigo

seguir (*to follow*): sigo

conseguir (*to get*): consigo

Salgo para Guatemala mañana.

I leave for Guatemala tomorrow.

Durante las vacaciones de primavera, hago mi tarea en la playa.

During spring break, I do my homework on the beach.
