# **What are reflexive verbs?**

**Reflexive verbs** are used when the subject of the sentence does an action to **itself**. In other words, the subject and the object are the same person or thing.

For example:

- Me cepillo el pelo. *I brush my hair.*

The person doing the brushing is the same person being brushed.

# *When do we use reflexive verbs?*

We often use reflexive verbs to talk about **routines** and **actions we do to ourselves**.

Here are a few examples of reflexive verbs:

- Lavarse *to wash*
- Bañarse *to bathe*
- Cepillarse *to brush*
- Ducharse *to shower*
- Vestirse *to get dressed*
- Afeitarse *to shave*
- Despertarse *to wake up*





# How to form reflexive verbs

**Paso 1.** Identify the verb.

- Lavarse

**Paso 2.** Conjugate the verb based on the subject and its corresponding –ar, -er, or –ir ending.

- Yo lavo

**Paso 3.** Add the corresponding reflexive pronoun.

Yo <b>me</b> lavo	Nosotros <b>nos</b> lavamos
Tú <b>te</b> lavas	Vosotras <b>os</b> laváis
Ella <b>se</b> lava	Ellos <b>se</b> lavan



# How to form reflexive verbs

Yo <b>me</b> lavo	Nosotros <b>nos</b> lavamos
Tú <b>te</b> lavas	Vosotras <b>os</b> laváis
Ella <b>se</b> lava	Ellos <b>se</b> lavan

You should place the reflexive pronoun (me, te, se, nos, os, se) before a conjugated verb.

- **Se** ducha a las cinco. *He showers at 5:00.*

If there are two verbs, you can place the pronoun before the conjugated verb or attach it to the end of the infinitive verb.

- **Se** va a duchar a las cinco. *He is going to shower at 5:00.*
- Va a ducharse a las cinco.



# Some examples

**Te acuestas** temprano.

*You go to bed early.*

**Ellos se cepillan** los dientes dos veces al día.

*They brush their teeth two times a day.*



**Nos maquillamos** porque vamos a una fiesta.

*We put on make-up because we are going to a party.*

**Voy a despertarme** a las seis esta semana para estudiar.

*I'm going to wake up at 6:00 this week to study.*
