



El pretérito del verbo *ir*

How do we form *el pretérito* of the verb *ir*?



The preterite tense of *ir* (to go) is used to describe completed actions of going to a specific place or event in the past.

In Spanish, the verb *ir* is **irregular** in the preterite tense. Note that none of the forms carry a written accent. Also, remember that the preposition “a” typically follows the verb *ir*.

IR (to go)	
Yo fui	Nosotros fuimos
Tú fuiste	Vosotras fuisteis
Ella fue	Ellos fueron

Some examples

El marzo pasado mis amigos y yo **fuimos** a Colorado para esquiar.

Last March my friends and I went to Colorado to ski.

Ayer **fui** al estadio Kinnick para mirar un partido de fútbol americano.

Yesterday I went to Kinnick Stadium to watch a football game.

¿Quién **fue** al concierto anoche?

Who went to the concert last night?
